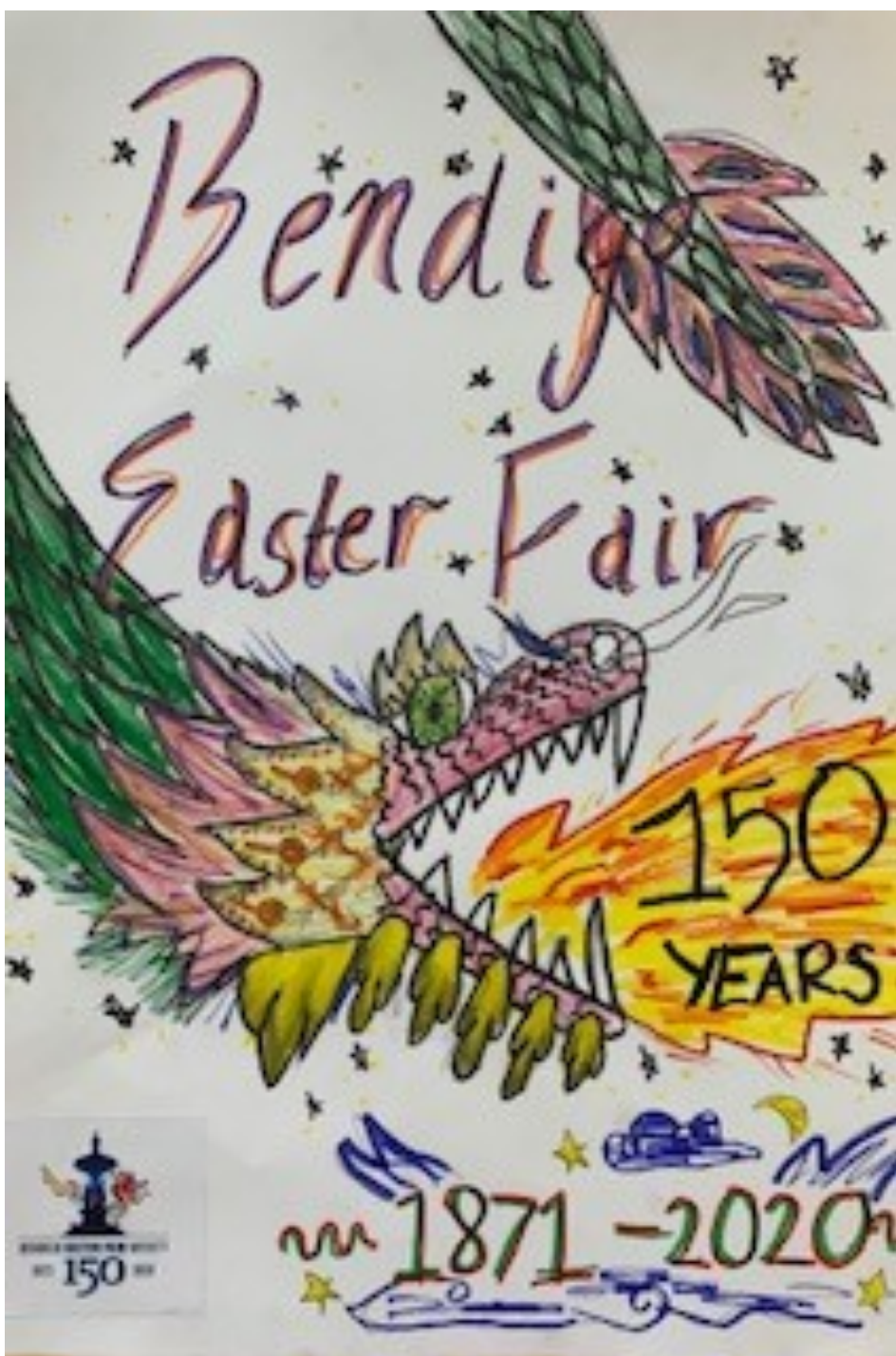
### **Marong’s Got Talent**
